



## Application for Temporary to Permanent Registration

If your horse has a Temporary Certificate of Registration you can apply for Permanent Registration by one of the following ways (circle one):

1. Provide proof of parentage of both sire and dam. If proper parentage is able to be qualified through the University of Kentucky DNA lab, send this form, the original Temporary Registration Certificate and new certificate fee of \$25 to the address below. If hair samples must be processed for the sire and/or dam there is a \$30 fee per sample in addition to the \$25 new certificate fee. Once both parents are confirmed the horse will receive a Registration Certificate and be registered in the regular Gypsy Vanner Studbook.
2. Apply for permanent registration once the horse has reached 3 years of age. Temporary Registration expires on the 5<sup>th</sup> birthday of the horse as stated on the Temporary Certificate. Send this form, 4 standard conformation type current photos of the horse (one from each side, one from front and one from rear), the original Temporary Registration Certificate and the \$50 Temp to Permanent processing fee to the address below. The horse will be evaluated for Permanent registration and once approved a Registration Certificate will be sent and the horse registered in the Pre Studbook of the GVHS.
