Advisory Council

(Task Force)

This committee will address concerns and matters that impacts upon the future of the GVHS. It can be best considered as a task force, which reviews the interests of the membership of the GVHS and the future of the organization.

This will provide a collecting point of information from the membership to discuss matters and challenges for building a stronger organization for the future.

- 1. It shall consist of no more than 10 people from the GVHS Membership and GVHS Show organizations and serve at the solicitation of the President
- 2. Appointees Can be removed or replaced by the current sitting President
- 3. The appointees Terms shall be one year, with continual review. There may be appointments of new replacements at the completion of a term.
- 4. Attendance and participation in the meetings and discussions is mandatory to remain on the council.
- 5. This will be a working group that meets quarterly during 2023, with an in-person meeting at the Annual GVHS Membership meeting starting in 2024. At that meeting a general summary of the council's activities will be provided to the GVHS membership.
- 6. This group will have a future positive impact on the GVHS
- 7. The Council may make recommendations to the GVHS Board of Directors for further action on matters as well as provide a report of their findings.

The objective will be to have a balance of interests represented through involvement with the GVHS, member owners, member breeders, member officials, member trainers, member show management, and members with international interests. This will not replace and/or presume the role of any of the currently existing committees, and will report directly to the President, who in turn can present to the Board of Directors.

The President can appoint an Advisory Council that presents recommendations and findings......And further, the Council can be disbanded as easily and quickly as it is created.

This provides a new additional dimension for communicating, and listening to the GVHS membership
