



## SHOW COMMITTEE

### **PURPOSE:**

The Show Committee, through the Show Coordinator, will collaboratively work with GVHS-approved show managers to support the planning, coordination, and execution of GVHS-approved shows, while providing education and consistency across the show program.

The expectation is for every committee to meet a minimum of once a month, take minutes and the chair / or a representative be on our voting meeting for the 3-5 minutes giving us their committee update

### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

#### Show Coordinator Responsibilities

- The Show Coordinator will serve as the Chairperson of the Show Committee
- Communication from the Show Committee will flow through the Show Coordinator
- Serve as the primary liaison between GVHS and approved show managers and exhibitors
- Serve as the primary contact for questions from show managers and participants
- Review show bills to ensure class lists are accurate, complete, and consistent with GVHS standards and approved point structures
- Oversee and maintain the GVHS point structure, including updates and clarifications as approved by the Board

#### Committee Responsibilities

##### Structure

- Committee members remain GVHS volunteer appointees

- The committee functions in a supportive and advisory capacity
- Provide education to members regarding:
  - Show formats
  - Class offerings
  - Point structures
  - Procedures related to GVHS-sanctioned shows
- Support show managers through coordination and guidance
- Assist with strategic development of show opportunities by:
  - Identifying geographic regions where additional sponsored shows are needed
  - Making recommendations regarding show division clarification or modification
- Offer feedback and recommendations to the Board as requested

### **Authority Clarification**

The Show Committee:

- Does not create rules - Rules will be handled by the LOC
- Does not interpret rules
- Does not enforce rules

All rule making, rule interpretation, enforcement, and final approval authority remains solely with the GVHS Board of Directors.
